

## James Earl Jones/Donald Crouch Sculpture Mentorship Project Guidelines for honoring Personal Mentors

As the project to highlight the relationship between James Earl Jones and his teacher, Donald Crouch has evolved, members of our organization have had conversations with community members about how “mentorships can be life-changing”. An idea has emerged that will allow people to recognize and honor individuals who have been their personal mentors.

The Arts and Culture Alliance of Manistee County has decided to create a “Wall of Mentors”, to be placed with the JEJ/DC sculptures at KND schools. The names of eligible nominated mentors will be inscribed on this wall. In order to make this new element of the project a reality here are the guidelines:

- An individual may be nominated by anyone who considers that person to be or continue to be a personal mentor.
- For a donation of \$100 that person’s name will be inscribed on the Wall of Mentors. The criteria applied will be the **personal** relationship one has had with the mentor. A person can nominate more than one mentor but \$100 is due with each.
- A name will appear only once even if a person is nominated more than once.
- This project will start on November 15, 2021 and names will be received until May 31, 2022. It is possible that the date will be extended but this date will assure completion dates that coordinate with statue installation.
